Plan A

Classroom Presentation

Cost = \$5.00 per student

- Your students will plant and grow their own bulb or seed to take home or we can plant in your school garden.
- The Flower Fields® will provide all plant materials, soil, and pots.

Two Part Program

Cost = \$10.00 per student

Part 1: CLASSROOM PRESENTATION

- Classroom presentations are available September through February
- Presentations are suitable for preschool (ages 4 & up) through 5th grade
- A Flower Fields® teacher will come to your classroom to give a 1-hour slideshow presentation.

On Site Growing Program

Cost = \$10.00 per student

- The Growing program is available March 15th through April 30th
- Presentations are suitable for preschool (ages 4 & up) through 5th grade
- Each student will receive a pot, soil and sunflower seeds to plant and take home.

On Site presentation will include:

- Composting with worms
- Craft project
- Music activities
- Wagon Ride

Composting Program

Our composting program teaches students the principles of recycling, using worms as the “world’s greatest recycler”. Each composting session is taught by a Master Composter. Worms are a fun way for kids to learn about recycling and to become more aware of their environment.

Antique Tractor Wagon Rides

Students will enjoy a ride on an open-air wagon pulled by an antique tractor.

Craft Program

Students will create a special “hands-on” craft project to take home.

Music Program

Students will enjoy singing songs like “Dirt made my lunch” and “Bees have power” that both teach and entertain.
